

AQUATICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORT

REGULAR MEETING
THURSDAY, MARCH 12, 2015, AT 1:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Aquatics Advisory Committee (AAC) was called to order by the Chairman, Jo Jones, at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 12, 2015, in the Board Room at Gateway Complex.

Present, in addition to the Chairman, were Judith L. Morton, Marilyn Mansfield, Dale O. Reynolds, and Brian K. Stack. Susie L. Chiang and Norman P. Gorsuch were excused. Also attending were Mary Lou Delpech and Melvin N. Wall, Directors, GRF Board; and Jeffrey P. Matheson, Director of Resident Services. Attendance

Due to a lack of a quorum, the Committee did not meet in February. No February Meeting/

The Chairman commented on our results for 2014 and hoped that 2015 would be even better. Chairman's Report

During the Resident's Forum, Jiayi Zhou brought to the attention of the AAC some results of a meeting he attended for the Bay Area Public Pool Operators Association Management (BAPPOAM) on February 17th. His comments were also distributed to the GRF Board. Residents' Forum

Mr. Reynolds presented the pool numbers as of February 28, 2015. It was noted that pool attendance for Del Valle was up 4.90% for the month of February. Dollar Pool and Hillside Pool were closed for the month of February. He also pointed out that visits to Del Valle for February were up 3.43% over the same period last year. Pool Attendance

Mr. Stack noted that the Rossmoor News has been advertising weekly that Hillside and Dollar Pools are open until November 30. He commented on the fact that the Swimming Saves Lives Program was a complete success, and he will continue to work to expand the program.

Mr. Matheson brought the Committee up-to-date regarding the Board action concerning controlled access and guest fees. He said that the GRF Board requested that the Joint Sub-Committee review their recommendations. Controlled Access and Guest Fees

A motion was made by Ms. Morton that any Guest Fee should be ONLY for the Del Valle complex and NOT for Hillside or Dollar Pool. The motion was seconded by Ms. Mansfield and CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY. Recommendation re. Guest Fee

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:28 p.m. Adjournment


