A regular meeting of the Aquatics Advisory Committee (AAC) was called to order by the Chairman, Brian K. Stack, at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, February 11, 2016, in the Board Room at Gateway Complex.

Also attending were Leslie Birdsall, President, and Mary Lou Delpech, Secretary, GRF; Jeffrey P. Matheson, Director of Resident Services; Hideyo Routh, Head Lifeguard; and one resident. Attendance

The report of the Committee's regular meeting of January 14, 2016, was approved as presented. Report Approved

Sara Jane McDowell asked the Committee to have the locker rooms at Hillside up to normal heat temperature once the pool opens. Mr. Matheson said that he will arrange for that to happen. Residents' Forum

Mr. Reynolds was asked to create an article for the Rossmoor News about issues regarding the Del Valle pool. The topics to be discussed are time spent in the Jacuzzi for health reasons and information regarding the opening of Hillside and Dollar Pools on March 1, 2016. Rossmoor News Article
