

AQUATICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORT

REGULAR MEETING
THURSDAY, MARCH 9, 2017, AT 1:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Aquatics Advisory Committee (AAC) was called to order by the Chairman, Brian K. Stack, at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 9, 2017, in the Board Room at Gateway Complex.

Present, in addition to the Chairman, were Dale O. Reynolds, Secretary, Norman P. Gorsuch, Barbara S. Jordan, Carol A. Meehan, and Mary Lou Delpech, GRF Board representative and ex-officio member. E.J. Koch and Judith L. Morton were excused. Also attending were Timothy O'Keefe, CEO; Jeffrey P. Matheson, Director of Resident Services; Hideyo Routh, Head Lifeguard; and two residents. Attendance

The report of the Committee's regular meeting of February 9, 2017, was approved as written. Report Approved

During the Residents' Forum, William Cohen expressed deep concern about the change in policy regarding family swim at Hillside pool. William Knickerbocker said he was concerned about the lighting in the exercise pool, emphasizing that some areas were too dark and needed better lighting. Residents' Forum

Mr. Reynolds presented the attendance report for February. Pool usage for Del Valle during the month of January was down 13% from the previous year. The Hillside and Dollar pools were not open in February. Pool Attendance

Mr. Matheson brought the Committee up to date regarding the Del Valle Complex Renovation Project. He said that the GRF Board approved the bid from Tilton Pacific Construction, Inc. The Complex will close on Monday, March 13th, and temporary fitness facilities will hopefully be open to residents on Monday, April 3rd. Based upon the contractor's schedule, Mr. Matheson said that he thought the Del Valle pool would be closed from April through June. Update on Del Valle Complex Renovation Project

The Committee discussed the possibility of renaming the Del Valle Complex and interior rooms, and the procedure for same. The Committee agreed to recommend to the GRF Board that the Del Valle Complex and interior rooms be renamed via a process using resident input. Suggestions from residents can then be reviewed by a joint subcommittee of the AAC and FCAC to provide a recommendation to the Board. Procedure to Rename Del Valle Complex

The Chairman reported that he received two pieces of correspondence from residents Janis and Joseph Hoffman and Jane Viator. Both pieces of correspondence were related to the AAC's summer policy regarding family swim at the Hillside pool and all were not happy with the decision to change the policy. The Chairman noted that, to date, the AAC has received only three complaints regarding family swim. The Committee respects the residents' comments but feels Correspondence

the policy should not be changed at this time.
