

AQUATICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE REPORT

REGULAR MEETING THURSDAY, MAY 14, 2015, AT 1:30 P.M.

A regular meeting of the Aquatics Advisory Committee (AAC) was called to order by the Chairman, Jo Jones, at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 14, 2015, in the Board Room at Gateway Complex.

Present, in addition to the Chairman, were Judith L. Morton, Vice Chairman, Dale O. Reynolds, Secretary, Norman P. Gorsuch, Marilyn Mansfield, and Brian K. Stack. Also attending were Jeffrey P. Matheson, Director, Resident Services; Mary Lou Delpech Secretary, GRF; and two residents. Attendance

The Chairman commented on the need to include the word "Aquatics" in the new mission statement and that the complex should be called "Del Valle Complex." She also suggested that, in future joint meetings with the Fitness Center Advisory Committee, all speakers participating in the Residents' Forum should "stay on subject." Chairman's Report

Mr. Reynolds presented the pool numbers as of April 30, 2015. It was noted that the overall pool attendance was down -4.34%. Dollar Pool attendance was down -11.24%, Hillside Pool was down -22.80% and Del Valle Pool was up 4.38%. There was discussion about the numbers without any consensus as to why they were down. The Environmental Guidelines at Del Valle Pool were discussed. Rules have been established and are available at the pool. It was suggested that the guidelines be published in the Rossmoor News to show users the guidelines that staff is working with. The Committee deferred discussion of the outdoor pool schedule for the 2016 season to a future meeting. 2016 Outdoor Pool

Mr. Gorsuch brought up a concern with the bathing suit water extractors in the locker rooms. He requested that a notice be put in place to announce that pool shoes should not be used in the water extractors because of breakdown issues. Mr. Matheson will check into this for the Committee. Mrs. Morton requested a new time clock for Hillside Pool, as the existing one has reached its useful life. Mr. Stack will work with Mr. Matheson to make some recommendations. Time Clock at Hillside
