



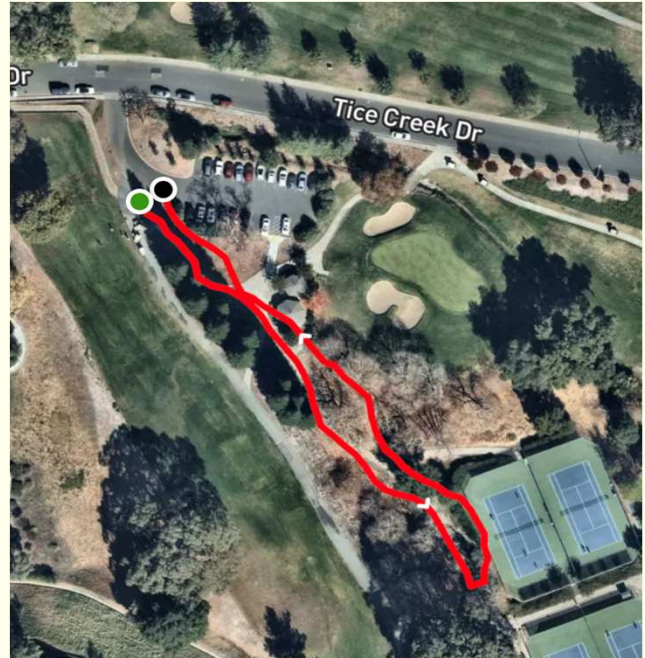
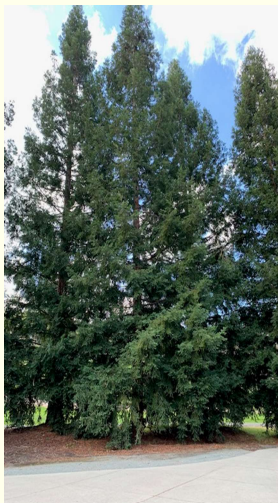
## BUCKEYE GROVE Walking Trail

Trail that passes Buckeye Grove and a Redwood planting for a close-up look of these California native trees.



Buckeyes (*Aesculus californica*) conserve water by going dormant in summer, dropping their leaves when the temperature gets too warm. They are the first trees to leaf out early in spring.

Redwoods (*Sequoia sempervirens*) are some of the world's fastest growing trees. They occur naturally in groves and often share root systems.



**Length:** 0.2 Miles

**Difficulty:** Easy and flat

**Location:** Start from Buckeye Parking Lot near the corner of Avenida Sevilla and Tice Creek Drive. DO NOT walk on the golf course side of the trees

**Bathrooms:** In Buckeye Parking Lot

**Parking:** Buckeye Parking Lot or Along Tice Creek

**Benches:** No
