

- I. Title: Demonstrations on GRF Property
- II. Purpose: To provide a safe platform for public demonstrations by GRF Members and Approved Rossmoor Organizations as defined in Policy 302.0.
- III. Application Process
 1. An Application to Demonstrate is required for all demonstrations, whether by a GRF Member or a Rossmoor Organization. Application to Demonstrate forms are available at the Public Safety Office and online at MyRossmoor.com.
 2. An Application to Demonstrate must be submitted by a GRF Member or by a Rossmoor Organization president to the Public Safety Manager or the Securitas Site Manager three business days before the planned demonstration. The Public Safety Manager will forward the application to the General Manager who will act upon it in a timely manner.
 3. In the case of an event that occurs in an immediate 24-hour period that is of such magnitude that a three-workday application process would be unsuitably long, an “Urgent” application process shall be available. When a GRF Member or Rossmoor Organization desires to conduct a demonstration they deem urgent, they shall submit the Application to Demonstrate, noting “Urgent Demonstration”, to the Public Safety Manager or the Securitas Site Manager. The Public Safety Manager will contact the General Manager or designee who will act upon it in a timely manner.
 4. The request to demonstrate can be denied for reasons of safety or inflammatory content as determined by the General Manager. Examples of inflammatory content include but are not limited to hate speech, discriminatory or disparaging words, acts, or visuals that may shock the conscience of the community as determined by the General Manager. A GRF Member or Rossmoor Organization president has the right to appeal a denial to demonstrate. The appeal shall be directed to the President of the GRF Board.
- IV. Location, Frequency, and Hours of Demonstrations
 1. All demonstrations on GRF property, except approved GRF Organization parades which are allowed to use the Rossmoor roadways, shall be located outdoors on the west side of Rossmoor Parkway in the space north of the current Creekside courts and south of Saklan Indian Drive.
 2. Demonstrations must be held during daylight hours and may start no earlier than 8:00 AM. GRF Member and Rossmoor Organization demonstrations are limited to one demonstration per two weeks for a maximum of 4 daylight hours.
 3. Organizers must ensure that demonstrators do not impede vehicle or pedestrian traffic. All demonstrators must adhere to state and local laws and ordinances.
 4. Signs and visuals must be handheld. They may not be waved into the roadway or sidewalk. Signs may not be fixed into the ground or hung from trees, fences, or other

objects. EXCEPTION: A “Please Do Not Honk” sign must be displayed in a location that is clearly visible to vehicle drivers but is not on the roadway. This sign may be handheld or fixed to a free-standing object during the demonstration.

5. The use of amplified sound is strictly prohibited.
6. Demonstration organizers must ensure that all materials and litter are removed at the end of the demonstration. Organizers are responsible for the cost of repair of damage to GRF property.

V. Enforcement

1. Violations of this policy may result in denial of future demonstration applications, suspension of access to GRF amenities, and monetary fine per GRF Policy 100: Policy Enforcement Notification.

VI. Additional Information

1. The Golden Rain Foundation (GRF) has the legal right to allow or deny GRF Members to demonstrate on its property, subject to all requirements outlined in this policy. This permission to demonstrate can be revoked or revised at any time by a decision of the GRF Board of Directors.
2. Demonstrations on GRF property are available only to individual GRF Members and GRF Members of Rossmoor Organizations.
3. This policy applies only to demonstrations on GRF property. It does not apply to actions on Mutual property. Mutuals have the right to establish all policies within their respective boundaries.

4. Definitions of terms:

For this policy, demonstration shall refer to outdoor gatherings on GRF property, including but not limited to actions of protest or support, vigils, and parades.
