Come learn how this will impact your neighborhood and how you can be more prepared for wildfires and other emergencies. The City of Walnut Creek, alongside the Golden Rain Foundation and our supporting agencies, is coordinating the evacuation drill for **residents in the Mutual 68 (WCR-E002) neighborhood ONLY.** This exercise is designed to test our ability to manage a large-scale evacuation.

Residents of Mutual 68 who wish to participate in the drill must register in advance in order to receive alerts & instructions from the Contra Costa County Community Warning System (CWS).


On May 15, after receiving the alert from CWS, participants should drive to the Temporary Evacuation Point located at Heather Farm Park Ball Field 1 parking lot. In order to minimize traffic disruptions, there are two possible routes you will be directed to take. Please follow Walnut Creek Police Department (WCPD) & WC CERT instructions as you exit Rossmoor. Drill participants should place the orange "Rossmoor Drill" placard on their vehicle dashboard so that first responders are able to identify participants.

We realize that this may inconvenience some residents and hope you will understand what an incredible learning experience this will be for our first responders and the community. With the recent fires in our state, we have seen how important a well-practiced evacuation can be. Thank you!

- **STEP 5.** On May 15, after receiving the alert from CWS, evacuate your residence immediately
- **STEP 6:** Follow instructions from those conducting traffic control as you exit Rossmoor
- **STEP 7:** Drive to the temporary evacuation point at Heather Farm Park, Ball Field 1 Parking Lot
