

Subject: Dog Park

Purpose: To Establish Rules for Use of the Dog Park

The Dog Park is open daily from 8:00 a.m. to dusk. Except Thursdays from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. for routine cleaning.

1. Aggressive dogs are not permitted.
2. Dog biting/fighting with other dogs must be reported to Rossmoor Public Safety so an incident report can be taken. Animal owners can report such incidents to the responsible public agency, the Contra Costa County Animal Services, for follow-up investigation.
3. Dogs biting humans must be reported to Rossmoor Public Safety so an incident report can be taken and any emergency medical aid rendered. Animal owners or bite victims can report such incidents to the responsible public authority, Contra Costa County Animal Services, for follow-up investigation.
4. Residents responsible for dogs brought to the park must be in the park, within view of the animal(s), and have them in voice command.
5. Dogs must be leashed when entering or leaving.
6. Female dogs in heat are prohibited from entering the park.
7. Residents responsible for dogs brought to the park must control excessive barking by the dogs.
8. No furniture or sharp objects are allowed on the artificial turf area.
9. Residents responsible for dogs brought to the park must clean up any dog feces left by their animals.
10. Residents responsible for dogs brought to the park must fill in any holes dug in the dirt areas by their animals.

These rules shall be posted at the dog park along with a separate posting of the telephone numbers for Rossmoor Public Safety and for County Animal Services.

Violation

Violations of policies, procedures, or rules will be reviewed and acted upon consistent with Policy 100, which may be found on the myrossmoor.com website or upon request at

the administrative offices at Gateway Clubhouse.
