- Subject: Cooking and General Open Flame Restrictions on Golden Rain Foundation ("GRF") Property During "Red Flag Warning" Periods
- Purpose: To establish a Rule prohibiting the use of any open flame on all GRF property during "Red Flag Warning" periods
- Applicability: This Rule applies to all persons while on GRF property, to include open spaces, outdoor recreational facilities, parks, trails and all other outdoor areas owned or controlled by GRF, during a Red Flag Warning period.
- Definitions: **Open Flame Grilling** means the use of any device that relies on a combustible fuel and an open flame, whether to cook food or for any other purpose, regardless of type or ownership of such device. For example, grills relying on wood, charcoal, propane, and other combustible fuels, to cook food, whether owned and permanently installed by GRF, or portable devices regardless of owner.

**<u>Red Flag Warning</u>** means a notice issued by the National Weather Service and/or any applicable state/local authority of the likelihood of onset of critical weather and/or conditions conducive to increased risk of open land wildfire activity. Such warnings are usually issued when weather conditions are forecasted to include extreme heat, dry and/or windy conditions. Such warnings can usually be found at: www.fire.ca.gov and/or www.weather.gov/mqt/redflagtips

Requirements: GRF shall prohibit the use of any/all open flame grilling, cooking or other means of food preparation and/or any other activity that involves the use of any means of combustion, on any outdoor property owned or controlled by GRF, during any period when a Red Flag Warning has been issued and remains in effect.

> Residents and their guests must comply with these restrictions on Golden Rain Foundation Property during any/all Red Flag Warning periods.

Violations: Violation of this rule may result in the suspension of use privileges of GRF amenities pursuant to applicable GRF policy. Additionally, violators may be subject to any/all applicable civil/criminal penalties imposed by law and may be liable for any/all resulting damages.
